In this vein, we are planning to run a structured 2-week residential in the summer holiday period. These will run in two consecutive batches and will be age specific. These sessions should be able to accommodate around 50 girls, so we encourage keen participants to start booking there places. As if that is not exciting enough, we are soon to go on another weekend residential this month (20th - 22nd February) in Surrey. This intensive activity based residential is a great opportunity for team building, problem solving and dealing with challenges.



Future Plans

We are planning to extend our weekday workshop sessions. These currently run from 4pm -6pm but we often find that many girls are very hungry and distracted having had their last meal at 1pm in the afternoon. Some end up snacking on unhealthy treats and junk food. To combat this and promote healthy eating habits, we will structure the sessions to run from 4pm -7pm with a 45-minute break for a healthy and filling home-cooked evening meal. The new changes will take effect from Monday 2nd March 2015. We welcome donations in support of the new dinner scheme.
