September was a very busy but highly productive month for us at Rosebud. In addition to our regular weekly schedule, we have crammed in lots and lots of other great activities including: a project awareness open day in partnership with the young people at NCS (National Citizen Service), a RoseGarden workshop with mothers of our service users, a workshop on young women's safety in partnership with Rape Crisis, 4 pilot sessions for Baby & Me - a workshop for teenage mums, launched Saturday workshops tagged Me, Myself & I, made a documentary on World Peace, as well as a night out to the Sing4Peace event at Stratford Circus for Peace One Day!

As a team, we have also reflected on the past (academic) year, and we have listened to, and are working with our young women to improve our services and implement change when and where necessary. We will be launching a membership scheme on an 'opt in' basis, whereby regular service users who are members of Rosebud will gain access to exclusive events, merchandise and other benefits.



Membership Scheme

Rosebud will be launching an annual membership scheme commencing from September 2015. The duration will fall in line with the academic year: September - August and will be renewable in September annually. The cost is £20, a sum which was suggested by parents - it is payable at the time of registration. Existing service users can pay by cash or cheque issued to Listening Ears.
